Dear Student and Parent

Congratulations on completing a very busy year and a hectic exam schedule; I hope you gain the results that you deserve with your GCSEs. As I have previously mentioned, we have some Sixth Form taster days being held from 7th to 9th July; the purpose of these is to give you a further insight into the courses you have selected to study in September as well as getting a head start by completing some preparatory work for your studies.

During these days you will be considered and treated as a Sixth Former, therefore you do not need to wear your school uniform and, should you wish and your parents agree, you can leave the school site during lunch and break times. I am sure that all of you will gain a great deal from this session as it sure to be powerful, moving but also inspirational.

On Wednesday we hope to hold a social event after school; in order to keep costs to £10, we would like to have a meal at 'Etc.' in the village straight after school. You will need to arrange for collection from the Community Centre at approximately 17.30.

I hope that you will be able to attend the taster days to see what our Sixth Form has on offer for you when you join us in September. I am very much looking forward to your continued success with the next stage of your academic career.
